

# **Primary Pediatrics Schedule for Well Child Exams with Immunization Schedule**

--**Newborn Visit** around day 4-7 of life – Hepatitis B given in hospital or at this visit

--**1 month old Visit** – Hepatitis B #2

--**2 month old Visit** – Pentacel #1 (DTaP, Hib, IPV), Pneumococcal #1, Rotavirus #1

--**4 month old Visit** - Pentacel #2 (DTaP, Hib, IPV), Pneumococcal #2, Rotavirus #2

--**6 month old Visit** - Pentacel #3 (DTaP, Hib, IPV), Pneumococcal #3, Rotavirus #3

--**9 month old Visit** – Hepatitis B #3, Hemoglobin finger stick

--**12 month old Visit** – MMR/Varicella #1, Hepatitis A #1

--**15 month old Visit** – Pentacel #4 (DTaP, Hib, IPV), Pneumococcal #4

--**18 month old Visit** - Hepatitis A #2

--**2 year old Visit**

--**3 year old Visit**

--**4 year old Visit** – MMR/Varicella #2, DTaP/IPV #4

--**Yearly Check-Up 5yo-10yo**

--**11 yo Check-Up** – Tdap, Meningococcal #1, HPV series

--**Yearly Check-Up 12yo-15 yo**

--**16 yo Check-Up** – Meningococcal #2, Men B series

\*\*All Check-Ups include evaluation of growth, development, nutrition, safety, mental health evaluation, puberty status, scoliosis screen, and anticipatory guidance. During yearly exams, refills on chronic medication and paperwork for school as well as sports can be filled out.

\*\*This schedule may vary based on spacing of immunizations, growth, or other concerns. This schedule does not include the annual flu immunizations which is recommended for all children. Any vaccines can be discussed with your provider, as well as new immunizations when available.
