4. Does your child understand prepositions: in, on, etc?
5. Does your child try to sing or hum melodies?
6. Is your child able to locate body parts on a doll and many pictures in books?
7. Does your child give his/her listener good eye contact when he/she is speaking to someone?
8. Does your child recognize new words daily at an increasing rate? Does he/she recognize most common objects and know what they are used for?
9. Does your child have a vocabulary of at least 50-60 words?
10. Is your child beginning to combine two or more words into phrases?
11. Is your child's spoken language at least 50% understandable?
12. Does your child ask for wants by naming the object?
13. Does your child refer to himself/herself by name?
14. Does your child imitate two word productions: "Go store," "Want more", etc?
15. Does your child ask for food or drink when hungry or thirsty?
16. Does your child sometimes begin a conversation?
